RULES OF GOLF

- Members are requested to study the Rules of Golf and Course Guide and such local rules and temporary rules as may be posted on the Club notice board(s), and Blog and to apply and observe these rules at all times while playing.

COMPETITIONS

- All Club Competitions, except for Matchplay are to be played within the parameters of the E.M.G.C. booking sheet. (or Kiosk and MI Club)
- Club Competition Rules are contained in this Programme of Fixtures.
- The daily ball and nearest the pin competitions shall only apply to those players in the Competition(s) of the day. Disqualification or DNF from the daily Competition(s) will also disqualify those players from the ball and nearest the pin competitions.
- Minimum of 4 players is required to form a Competition.
- When playing a Matchplay round, a player cannot at the same time play in the competition of the day.
- When a competition is played in divisions, and due to insufficient entries in either division, the competition may be converted to a no division competition at the discretion of the Match Committee/Convenor.
- The lowest handicap player in any group of players should endeavour to see that the Rules of Golf (including Local and Temporary Rules), and the Rules of Etiquette (especially relating to slow play) are observed at all times so that others may enjoy their game of golf.
- Any protest must be lodged with the Captain or a member of the Committee before 6 pm on the day of the Competition in question. Such protest must be signed by the member making the protest and must contain the grounds upon which the protest is made.
- An invited guest may play in club competitions no more than six (6) times per syllabus year.
- Any player not financial after 31st July will be ineligible to enter a competition or play in Matchplay competitions. Please refer to the Rules of Association.

MEN'S HANDICAP COMPETITION

- When competitions are played in two divisions, the handicap ranges are:

V.G.L. Events:

“A” Division: Scratch – 18

“B” Division: 19 – maximum 36 for any V.G.L. event.

Club Competitions:

“A” Division: Scratch – 12

“B” Division: 13 – 36 (M) 45 (L) Refer to specific competitions for exceptions.

LADIES HANDICAP COMPETITIONS

- Handicap range Scratch - 45

HANDICAP APPLICATION

- A prospective new member may commence rounds for handicap, only after completing a signed membership form and the payment of the required nomination fee.
- Three (3) cards are required for handicap purposes. A card must be returned on each day of play and the 3 cards completed within three (3) months.
- Cards for handicap should be played on the Member's home course, but other cards may be acceptable if properly marked and signed by the holder of an Australian Handicap and marked with the date of play and the Course Rating of the course on which played. The member's name must appear in block capitals with his signature.
- An Australian Handicap cannot be allocated until such time as applicant is approved by the Executive Committee and any outstanding fees are paid.
- A handicap will lose its full status if a player should accrue in their most recent 20 Actual Scores five or more entries with a status of 'No Score – Not Approved'.
- Players with Provisional GA Handicaps will not be eligible to win prizes in competitions which have as a condition of entry a requirement that competitors hold GA Handicaps.
- Full status is automatically regained upon the number of 'No Score – Not Approved' entries in the player's most recent 20 Actual Scores decreasing to four or less.
- Players who are close to or have reached five entries with a status of 'No Score – Not Approved' will be advised.
- A member who belongs to more than one affiliated club, must nominate one club as his home club.

HOLE – IN – ONE

- For any member achieving a Hole-in-One, the Club will
 - ▶ Purchase one basic drink per member in their playing group only.
 - ▶ Provide a \$50 Voucher.
 - ▶ Provide a Trophy.
 - ▶ Have your name listed on the Hole-in-One board.

EAGLES

- Members achieving an Eagle will receive 6 golf balls and an eagle pin.

NOTE: A hole-in-one overrides an eagle. Revised 2016

COMPLAINTS

- Any complaint in relation to the conduct of a Member or any other matter, shall be in writing, (or Email) signed and lodged with the Captain or the Secretary no later than 6 pm on the day. The Secretary shall refer the matter to the Captain who can either deal with the matter himself or refer it to the Executive Committee for a decision.

MATCHPLAY

- All Matchplay competitions and playoffs are to be played on current handicaps at the time of play unless otherwise stated.
- All Matchplay competitions are to be played off the Tee in which the daily comp is being played
NOTE: Maximum handicaps may apply – refer to individual competitions for details.
- Men's Matchplay Index to be used for all competitions with the exception of Ladies versus Ladies Matchplay.
- A player who does not wish to qualify for Matchplay competitions is to indicate with an asterisk (*) against their name on the qualifying competition entry sheet.
- Defending Champion(s), if available, automatically qualify for all Matchplay competitions.

FOUR BALL MATCHPLAY – COMPETITION GUIDELINES

- Substitution of a team member is acceptable only up until the first round played – one of the original pairing must remain as part of the team.
- It is the responsibility of the nominated Team 2 to have direct contact with Team 1 to arrange date and time of play and to ensure that both members of Team 1 are aware of arrangements.
- Should time/date of play not be agreed; the CAPTAIN will designate time/date for the match to be played. Failure to comply with the CAPTAIN'S directions will result in the forfeiture of the match by the offending team(s).
- The winning team members will record the result on the competition sheet.

NOTES:

1. Should a match be tied after 18 holes; playoff will be made on the 18th hole. The Matchplay Index applied will be that from Hole 1, 2, 3 etc. onwards depending on the number of times the 18th is played to achieve the result. Players should be mindful that a concession can be arrived at by unanimous consent among the participants.
2. Playoff Men versus Ladies: The 18th Hole is to be played as a par 4 (Ladies Tee) for both indexes applied as per 1,2,3 etc...
3. Men versus Ladies Competitions: Special conditions apply to play on the 10th, 18th
Ladies play the 10th and 18th holes as Par 4's
Men must make a Par 3 on these holes to match the ladies Par 4 unless shots are given. Except for playoff where both play the 18th as a Par 4 off the Ladies tee.

SINGLES MATCHPLAY – COMPETITION GUIDELINES

- There will be no substitution of players after acceptances have closed.
- It is the responsibility of the nominated Player 2 to have direct contact with Player 1 to arrange date and time of play.
- Should time/date of play not be agreed; the CAPTAIN will designate time/date for the match to be played. Failure to comply with the CAPTAIN'S directions will result in the forfeiture of the match by the offending player.
- It is the responsibility of the winning player to record the result on the competition sheet.

NOTES:

- 1 Should a match be tied after 18 holes, playoff will be made on the 18th hole: the Matchplay Index applied will be that from Hole 1, 2, 3 etc. onwards depending on the number of times the 18th is played to achieve the result. Players should be mindful that a concession can be arrived at by unanimous consent among the participants.
- 2 Playoff Men versus Ladies: The 18th Hole is to be played as a par 4 for both indexes applied as per 1,2,3 etc...

Ladies play the 10th and 18th holes as Par 4's
Men must make a Par 3 on these holes to match the ladies Par 4 unless shots are given.
Except for playoff where both play the 18th as a Par 4 (Ladies Tee)

Competition Rules MEN'S

The following rules are always to be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf and such Local Rules as may apply at the time of play.

NOTE: In all competitions involving a partner, your partner CANNOT BE your marker on the score card.

1. CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS

Eligibility:

At least eight (8) non-NCR (Non-Conforming Round) scores in singles competition each year (in the period since the end of the previous Club Championships) and MUST be played in E.M.G.C. competition at the East Malvern Golf Club.

(Pennant matches to maximum of three (3) may be accepted as competition scores, subject to allowance by the Match Committee under special circumstances).

New members must have obtained a club handicap prior to the first competition round in December of the preceding year.

The applicable handicap is the player's E.M.G.C. blue tee handicap current on the first day of play for the Championships.

The player's grade shall be determined by their handicap. The grades for the Club championships are:

A GRADE: Scratch to 12 B GRADE:13 to 18 C GRADE:19 to Max 36

The Club Championships, in all Grades are to be conducted over 54 holes Stroke Play (for gross and nett scores)

The gross score will decide the overall Club Champion.

The nett scores will decide grade champions and runners up.

The GRADE a player qualifies for in the first round, shall be the GRADE for all the remaining rounds of the Championship. If a player's handicap changes during the course of the Championship, he will play off the amended handicap in the next round of the Championship.

In the event of a tie for the Club Champion or Grade Champion, a play-off is to be over an 18-hole stroke round. If scores remain tied at the end of the play-off, then the 18th hole shall be replayed until a winner is determined.

A separate Nett competition is run on each of the 3 rounds and should a player's handicap be varied from an earlier round, he is then to enter the Nett competition of the day, according to his ADJUSTED handicap.

In the final round of the Club Championships the best placed players in each grade of the championship will play in nominated groups of four with tee times being set by the Club Captain (or representative). Any player who fails to play in nominated group shall be disqualified from the Club Championships and the next best score will substitute in the place made vacant by the disqualification.

2. ECLECTIC COMPETITION

An eclectic competition is the best score per hole from nominated rounds.

The competition will be conducted concurrently with the three (3) rounds of the Club Championships and is to be for best Nett. The nett score is obtained by deducting one half (1/2) of the player's final round handicap from his gross score. The nett winners will be determined by the Committee. A tie shall be decided by a count-back.

3. V.G.L. MEDAL and E.M.G.C. Medal (STROKE)

The V.G.L. Medal competition is run under the auspices of the Victorian Golf League and the conditions of play are stipulated by the V.G.L. Match Committee. The competition is generally run on the first Saturday between the months of March and October (V.G.L. medal) and November and February, E.M.G.C. medal, and is to be over 18 holes stroke. The best Nett score on the day, from either division, is the Monthly Medal winner. All ties for a Medal are to be decided by use of the Australian count-back system until a decision is reached. Ties for "A" or "B" winners will be decided by the same method. Players with a handicap exceeding 36 will play off on Medal days.

4. GOLD MEDALLIST OF EAST MALVERN

The winners of each Monthly V.G.L. Medal will play-off in November and the winner to be the Gold Medallist of East Malvern. The winner MUST be available to play-off for the V.G.L. Medallist of Medallists on a date and course to be nominated by the V.G.L. (Any ties are to be decided by the Australian Count back method). Maximum handicap of 36 applies.

5. EAST MALVERN MEDAL DAY CHALLENGE Trophy

This competition is to be played on Medal days, with 32 players to qualify on the 2nd Saturday in February. On the next stipulated Medal Day, the best 16 scores of the original 32 will progress to the next round, and so on. The winner will be the best score of the last two players. In the event of tie on the day, a count-back will decide the winner.

6. EAST MALVERN MASTERS

Eight (8) pairs are to qualify for this event in a Nett Aggregate Stroke competition. The pair's aggregate handicap is NOT TO EXCEED 36 (Men), 45 (Ladies) or 40 (Mixed). In the qualifying round, it is not necessary for the partners to play together, but should they choose to do so, NO PLAYER IS TO MARK THEIR PARTNERS CARD under penalty of disqualification. All matches are to be played off the current handicap at the time of play, but not to exceed the stipulated aggregate handicaps. Handicaps for play are determined by deducting the low markers handicap (who plays off scratch) from each of the remaining three. These differences determine the number of stroke(s) that each of the three players get at holes according to the Matchplay Index on the card. All matches are to be played under the relevant match play guidelines.

Men's Matchplay Index to be used for all competitions except for Ladies versus Ladies Matchplay.

7. BEN BENNETT MEMORIAL 4 BALL KNOCKOUT

A notice for entries, nominating a closing date, will be posted. After the closing date, draw will be posted. Matches in this competition may be played either Saturdays or Sundays. All matches are to be played off the current handicap at the time of play and maximum handicap of 36 (Men) and 45 (Ladies) shall apply.

Handicaps for play are determined by deducting the low markers handicap (who plays off scratch) from each of the remaining three. These differences determine the number of strokes that each of the three players get, and at holes according to the Matchplay Index on the card.

All matches are to be played under the relevant match play guidelines.

Men's Matchplay Index to be used for all competitions except for Ladies versus Ladies Matchplay.

8. WINTER CUP

This is a Saturday Matchplay competition with sixteen (16) to qualify from a stroke competition. All matches are to be played off the current handicap at the time of play and a maximum handicap of 36 (Men) and 45 (Ladies) shall apply. Handicaps for play are determined by deducting the low markers handicap (who plays off scratch) from the higher handicap. This difference determines the number of strokes the player gets, and at holes according to the Matchplay Index on the card. All matches are to be played under the relevant match play guidelines.

Men's Matchplay Index to be used for all competitions except for Ladies versus Ladies Matchplay.

9. WINTER KNOCKOUT

This is a Sunday Matchplay competition with sixteen (16) to qualify from a stroke competition. All matches are to be played off the current handicap at the time of play and a maximum handicap of 36 (Men) and 45 (Ladies) shall apply. Handicaps for play are determined by deducting the low markers handicap (who plays off scratch) from the higher handicap. This difference determines the number of strokes the player gets, and at holes according to the Matchplay Index on the card. All matches are to be played under the relevant match play guidelines.

Men's Matchplay Index to be used for all competitions except for Ladies versus Ladies Matchplay.

10. SUNDAY CUP

This is a Sunday Matchplay competition, and the qualifying rounds are to be played on two consecutive Sundays in November. The first round is to be Stroke, the second Stableford, and eight (8) players on each Sunday, will qualify for a Matchplay draw. No player can qualify more than once. All matches are to be played at home, and off the current handicap at the time of play with a maximum handicap of 36 (Men) and 45 (Ladies) shall apply. Handicaps for play are determined by deducting the low markers handicap (who plays off scratch) from the higher handicapper. This difference determines the number of strokes that the player gets, and at holes according to the Matchplay Index on the card.

All matches are to be played under the relevant match play guidelines.

Men's Matchplay Index to be used for all competitions with the exception of Ladies versus Ladies Matchplay. (Revised 2016)

11. SUMMER CUP

Players must compete in each of three (3) rounds, played in January on consecutive Saturdays and scored on a system of points on the competition of the day. In the event of a tie, the method of play-off to determine the winner will be decided by the Match Committee. System of Points

Stableford: +1 or -1 point for each point over or under 36 points.

Stroke: +1 or -1 point for each stroke over or under the Course Par.

Par: +1 or -1 point for each plus or minus over or under square.

The winner is the player with the greatest number of points.

12. PRESIDENT'S AND CAPTAIN'S DAY

This competition is a Stableford round, and there will be no divisions run on this day. Prior to play, the President and Captain decide on a draw for teams. Once the teams have been decided, the scores are totalled up and the team with the highest score wins. There is a Trophy Donor for the best individual score from each team and in the event of a tie, a count-back shall determine the winner.

13. 2/3/4 PERSON MEDLEY AMBROSE

Male players play from the Male Competition Tees. Female players play from the Female Competition Tees.

TEAMS Play will be in groups of two (2), Three (3) or Four (4) players. (See match day competition. This is a Medley competition (Men and Women playing in the same competition). The team may be any combination of male and female players including all male or all females. Single players cannot compete.

Please note: READY GOLF applies to this event. (Added 2018)

THE SCORECARD:

► MUST show each team member's name, and handicap, and

All team members tee off each hole. The team chooses the shot they are going to use and mark its location.

Any player can then play the next shot by PLACING their ball within one club length of the marker on the same surface no nearer the hole, the other players can then PLACE their ball within one club-length of the selected position, no nearer the hole, and play their second shot.

This procedure of selecting continues until a ball is holed. Each ball must be placed on the same surface (fairway, rough, green, fringe or sand) as where the selected ball was marked. In a sand bunker, the sand may be raked prior to placing the ball. On the green when players putt, the other players' ball can be PLACED within one card-length of the selected spot.

Team members CAN stand on an extension of the line of play while putting. Each team member MUST have the following Tee shots:

- 4 player's at least THREE (3) tee shots
- 3 players at least FOUR (4) tee shots
- 2 players at least SIX (6) tee shots

The Scorer must record whose tee shot was used on EVERY hole. If this is not clearly marked on the card, the team may be subject to disqualification. At the conclusion of the round, the marker subtracts the team handicap from the gross stroke score to provide a Net Score.

The handicap of the team is calculated by combining the handicaps of the team the dividing by the following to arrive at the team handicap:

- a team of 2 golfers divide by 4
- a team of 3 golfers divide by 6
- a team of 4 golfers divide by 8

This is then subtracted from the Gross Score of the Team to arrive at the Nett Score.

Where necessary, fractions should be included in the calculations. (Revised 2018)

14. JIM PRYDE MEMORIAL FOUR SEASONS Trophy

This competition is to be played over four (4) rounds of stroke play. The rounds are to be played in Autumn (April), Winter (June), Spring (September) and the final round in Summer (December) for a perpetual trophy and winner voucher. The lowest Nett aggregate over the four rounds is the winner. In the event of a tie, a play-off is to be over 18 holes. In the event that scores remain tied at the end of the play-off, then the 18th hole shall be replayed until a winner is determined.

15. THE MICK REIDY MEMORIAL Trophy (African (Multi) Stableford)

Stableford rounds are played with a partner for a perpetual trophy and winners vouchers; HOWEVER, the team score for each hole is determined by multiplying the individual results achieved.

- Every player MUST have a Partner to be eligible for the competition.
- Threesomes are allowed – one “hinge” player to partner the other two – the “hinge” does not mark a card.
- Individual Stableford score cards are kept for each player (as per normal) – A Team Score Card can be filled out hole by hole or after the game (as preferred). The Team Score Card counts in the competition and scores claimed MUST be verifiable against individual performances.

16. CLEM SMITH MEMORIAL TROPHY

This is an annual event of a single round of stroke play for a perpetual trophy and winner voucher. In the event of a tie the winner shall be decided by count-back.

17. RICK CORBETT MEMORIAL PLATE

This is an annual event of a single round of Stableford play for a perpetual plate and winner voucher. In the event of a tie the winner shall be decided by count-back.

18. JIM KOZLOWSKI SHIELD

This is an annual event of a single round of Stableford play for an perpetual shield and winner voucher. In the event of a tie the winner shall be decided by count-back (Added 2014).

19 SUNDAY SHIELD

Each qualifying round shall be played as an 18-hole (Stroke, Par, or Stableford) round on the Sunday following the Saturday V.G.L. or E.M.G.C. medal during the months of February through November with a voucher presented to the winner of the event.

During the month of the club championship, the qualifying round will be played on the Sunday following the first round of the club championship.

All ties including the play-off of Shield qualifiers in December will be decided using the Australian countback system. Players with a handicap exceeding 36 (Men) and 45 (Ladies) will play off 36 and 45 respectively on qualifying round days.

20 WEDNESDAY CUP

The player who gains the most points from a 3,2,1 system (3 points for First, 2 points for Second, and 1 point for Third).

The competition runs each Wednesday from February to November with a voucher presented to the winner of the event.

21 WEDNESDAY SHIELD

Each qualifying round will be played as an 18-hole Stableford round on the Wednesday following the Sunday Shield qualifier during the months of February through November with a voucher presented to the winner of the event.

All ties including the play-off of Shield qualifiers in December will be decided using the Australian countback system. Players with a handicap exceeding 36 (Men) and 45 (Ladies) will play off 36 and 45 respectively on qualifying round days.

LADIES

1. CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS

This is an 18-hole stroke competition played over 3 rounds as determined in Fixture.

Eligibility - All Ladies who are financial with a current handicap and who have one 18-hole card returned in an E.M.G.C. competition for each of the three preceding months

The gross score will decide the overall Club Champion.

2. EAST MALVERN MEDAL

The E.M.G.C. Medal is a competition that is run on the first Saturday between the months of March and November, except during the Club Championships and is to be over 18 holes' stroke. The best Nett score on the day is the Monthly Medal winner. All ties for a Medal are to be decided by use of the Australian count- back system until a decision is reached. Maximum handicap will be 34.

3. MEDALLIST OF THE YEAR

The Winners of each monthly E.M.G.C. Medal will play- off in December and the winner to be the Medallist of the Year. Any ties are to be decided by the Australian Count back method. Maximum handicap of 34 applies.

4. ECLECTIC

An eclectic competition is the best score per hole from nominated rounds.

The competition will be conducted concurrently with the three (3) rounds of the Club Championships and is to be for the best Nett.

The nett score is obtained by deducting (7/8) of the player's final round handicap from the gross score. Ties are to be decided by a count-back.
